

Information Form for Patient of Removal Crown or Bridge

Removal of a crown or bridge can take it a long time.

There is a high risk of deformation/damage for restoration during the removal of a crown or bridge

The natural tooth may be fractured during the removal of a crown or bridge

There is a possibility that the tooth may become dislodged during the removal of the crown or bridge.

Since the abutment tooth is not visible radiologically, it is not possible to make a definitive diagnosis before removing the bridge.

After the crown or bridge is removed, prosthetic planning may change depending on the condition of the abutment teeth.

Bridge removal may be requested for treatments in other departments. If the crowns, bridges or abutment teeth are damaged and **prosthetic appointments are full, an appointment cannot be made for a new restoration.**
